## ACHIEVEMENTS OF IDSP FOR THE YEAR 2014 – 2015

- a) Collection of weekly epidemiological report from Government and Private Hospital, CHC, PHC, SHC and Sub-Centres. These reports are uploaded weekly to Central Surveillance Unit through IDSP Portal from each district by IDSP DEOs. Details given in Annexure I.
- b) Six (6) outbreak investigations were conducted during the year.

- c) Three (3) trainings were conducted for Medical Officers, Staff Nurses and Pharmacists.
- d) State Data Manager and Consultant (F & P), IDSP attended training conducted for North Eastern States on 31<sup>st</sup> July – 1<sup>st</sup> Aug, 2014 at SIHFW, Guwahati.
- e) Dr. Pachuau Lalmalsawma, State Nodal Officer, IDSP, Dr. Rothuama (MD) and Dr. T. Lalhmingmawii (Microbiologist) attended training on Ebola Virus Disease held at AIIH & PH, Kolkata on 17.11.2014 – 19.11.2014.
- f) Significant improvement is made in IDSP Portal Reporting compared to the previous years. To achieve this improvement 3G Wireless Dongle is purchased by SSU and is given to the districts for perusal.
- g) The newly emerging disease Scrub Typhus cases from all districts is collected by IDSP DEOs and reported to SSU. Details given in Annexure II.
